

## **BOY SCOUT CAMPING**

### **Rules**

1. The BSA guide to safe scouting will apply for all activities. National policy for uniforms and conduct will also apply.
2. Smoking is prohibited by Minsi Trails Council and Kutztown University. This is a non-smoking event.
3. Remember take only pictures and leave only footprints. Leave no Trace practices for high density camping apply. In 2006 and 2008 we were complemented for a low impact visit to KU. Let's earn those compliments again in 2010!
4. Use only walkways, cross streets at crosswalk only.
5. Act like scouts at all times, we will be visible to the public.
6. There are neighbors on lands near our camping areas and Kutztown University. For this reason, quiet hours are observed in the camping area between the hours of 11:00 pm and 6:00 am. Leaders are responsible to see that all scouts are in their own Unit's site during these hours.
7. Water availability is limited; bring as much water from home as possible.
8. Comfort stations are to be kept clean at all times. Your cooperation is essential to maintain these facilities in a clean and sanitary manner.
9. Digging is not allowed for any reason. This includes tent trenching, field toilets, etc.
10. No fires on the ground. No charcoal fires. No fires in barrels or half-barrels. All cooking is to be done with camping stoves only.
11. All tents & flys must be staked down so they do not become wind blown hazards.
12. Please confirm that special needs, e.g. handicap parking, or handicap camping are understood with the JAMBO Camp Masters.
13. We are guest of the Kutztown University and are expected to act like guest at all times. Always abide by the scout oath and law.

### **Ideas That Will Help Your Unit Have a Great Weekend**

- Bring only what you need for high-density camping. With over 5,000 Scouts and Scouters expected to camp for the weekend, it is strongly suggested that you bring only what you need.
- Each registered unit will receive one (1) parking pass for the parking lot that is closest to the camping area. This area will have sufficient space for each unit to have one vehicle / trailer combination in that space for the weekend. If you need more than one vehicle to carry your troop gear, please review item #1. If you still need more than your vehicle with a trailer can carry, you will have to unload that equipment and take that vehicle out of the parking area before using the pass to a second vehicle. Personal equipment is expected to be carried in from the parking areas to the camp sites. **PACK LIGHT.**
- Handicapped parking will be available, and that vehicle will not need a parking pass. The vehicle must display the appropriate placard or license plate in order to obtain access to this special parking area.
- In the past, some units have expressed concerns about the size of their respective camp site. Rest assured that everyone will receive an equal
- distribution of the available camping area. Please review item #1. **PACK LIGHT**
- Parking lots will open at 4:00 PM on Friday, May 14. Sites in the Boy Scout area have been assigned based on the order in which the unit's registration was received at the Minsi Trails Council office.
- Please complete your Unit Roster and Contact information before your arrival at JAMBO100. No Unit packets will be distributed until the completed roster and contact information is handed in at Camp Headquarters. **PACK LIGHT**
- Remember that we are guests of Kutztown University. We are extremely fortunate to have a host that is as generous as they are, and we want to continue to have more events there in the future. Leave the grounds in better condition than you found them.
- When you pack up on Sunday morning, please inspect your campsite to be certain that you removed all stakes and debris from your site. **PACK LIGHT**
- No open fires will be permitted. This also means charcoal fires in barrels, half-barrels, grills, hibachis, or any other container. Only camp stoves will be permitted in the camping areas.
- We appreciate all of your efforts to make this an enjoyable event. If you see something you like, let somebody know. If you see something you don't like, try to correct it, and if you cannot, let somebody know.
- If you enjoyed yourself, think about volunteering to help similar events happen in the future. Ask at your next District Roundtable about helping these events occur.
