Rules

1. Have Fun!
2. No alcohol, drugs, firearms, paintball guns, slingshots, bow and arrows, bikes, or skates/rollerblades are permitted.
3. Do not go in other Units campsites unless invited.
4. No holes bigger than a tent stakes.
5. Park in designated parking lots.
6. Follow Leave no Trace policy.
7. Remember! We are guests of Kutztown University.
8. Do not leave valuables in tents.
9. Please supervise you children
10. No wood or charcoal fires, cooking must be on propane stoves.
11. Have Fun!

Check-in Procedures and Tips

- Pack Light/bring a wagon or cart
- Follow traffic directions
- Parking passes will be mailed out
- Park in correct parking lots
- Unload gear
- Check-in at Cub Camping H.Q.
- Guides will take you to your campsites
- Set-up camp and have fun

What's provided?

- Port a potties in camping area (with hand sanitizer)
- Water
- Dumpsters for your trash

What to bring:

- Tent (each family is assigned a campsite according to the number of people they register). All families in a Pack will be grouped together.
- Sleeping bag, pillow.
- Weather appropriate clothes, good walking shoes. If we prepare for rain, it may not come!
- Food and cooking supplies. There are vendors on site for breakfast, lunch and dinner on Saturday if you'd rather not cook. Please note that open fires and charcoal are not allowed when we camp on the grounds of Kutztown University. Propane stoves should be your main cooking device.
- Containers for storing and hauling water.
- Flashlights, lanterns.
- A day pack for water and a jacket on Saturday.
