Parking Passes and Directions

-A parking pass for your unit is enclosed, which allows parking near your campsite. Additional parking is available for those without a pass. Signs will direct you to your lot.

Driving Directions

-The directions to Kutztown University are available on website. All traffic will enter town via Route 737 either from Route 78 or Route 222. Do **not** enter onto one of the Kutztown Main Street exits. Once in town, signs will be placed along the route in town to guide you. Also, the campus radio station will be broadcasting traffic info on 88.3 FM or 1670 AM. If you are outside of town, you can listen to the station via telephone at 610-465-7860. Last but not least, a campus map sharing traffic patterns and specific parking directions are available on the website.

Camping

-Remember, Boy Scouts and Cub Scouts will not be camping together. Also, no one other than Boy Scout leaders and their registered Troop youth members are allowed to camp in the Boy Scout area. Do not pack both the Troops and Packs gear in the same vehicle. Make sure you are familiar with the camping rules before arriving at Jambo. Camping rules are provided on the back of this sheet or in the Minsi News Edition #5.

Roster

-For those camping, please bring along a roster of youth and leaders attending to submit upon check-in. In case of Emergency, please include the cell phone numbers of your leaders attending. A blank roster form is available on the website.

Stadium Show

-For those who do not wish to sit on the bleacher, the field will be available to either stand or sit on the turf.

-No chairs will be allowed into the stadium. They will damage the field and seating on the track is prohibited

-It is advised that if you plan to sit on the turf, bring a blanket

-No food or drink will be allowed into the stadium

-Campsites will be released to enter the stadium in a staggered fashion starting at 6:30.

Crosswalks-Programs and activities are on both sides of Main Street, please use the designated crosswalks only

Weekend Schedule-A schedule for the weekend is available on the website

Wristbands-All paid participants will receive a wristband, which will be distributed when you check into your camping area. (if you are RV camping, your materials will be with your unit) If you are only coming for Saturday, your wristband will be available at the info tent. (Park in either the large lot off of College Boulevard or the Fairgrounds parking lot, the tent is in front of the Student Union Building)

Trading Post-Located at the same location as the info tent. All pre-ordered Jambo merchandise will be available at this location for pickup. Limited availability of other merchandise will be available.
